## *How can \$40 make a difference?*

Emerging leaders are selected and sent to Bible School or Seminary by their home churches and districts. Each district is responsible to raise funds to support its students. Since it is not possible to work during the training period, each student also maintains a garden to help support his family.

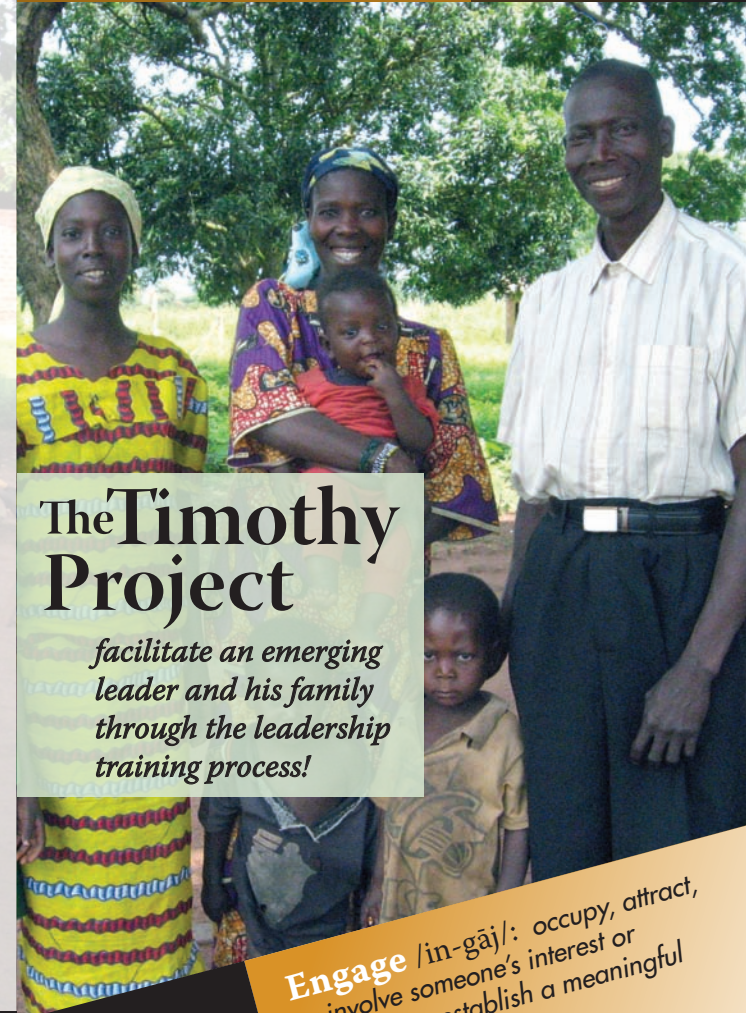
The Timothy Project provides approximately one-half of the educational costs including school supplies, lessons, faculty expenses, and emergency medical needs, to reduce the financial strain on the student's family.

NOTE: Seminary students require three sponsors per month (a total of \$120/month).

The Timothy Project is a ministry of Grace Brethren International Missions in partnership with the Grace Brethren Churches of the Central African Republic. Support is available for students who attend authorized training institutions. The Bible Institutes are located in Bata, Batangafo, Bossangoa and Mbaiki. The Seminary offers Master's Degrees and is located in Bangui.
