Engage 5 is an intensive training course which **Presents** and **Practices** knowledge and skills that are essential to effectiveness in cross cultural ministry.

Present:

We believe there are 5 main areas to be considered in the preparation process. During the Engage 5 course the mornings are used to present these topics.



Discipleship Be- Understanding our identity in Christ and the importance of an ongoing relationship with God.

Discipleship Make- Learning strategies and skills for a discipleship ministry.

Cross Cultural Acumen- Acquiring the skills and mindset for adjusting to a new culture.

Team- Understanding the values and barriers to strong teams.

Language- Recognizing the value of communicating in a heart language.

(The skills of language learning are taught in a separate venue.)

Practice:

Participants use afternoons and evenings to put into practice the knowledge and skills learned in the class—primarily in Clarkston and at Mercer University.
